
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M HEALTH FAIRVIEW LAKES MEDICAL CENTER PGY1 Pharmacy Residency





Program Overview

M Health Fairview Lakes Medical Center is a 60-bed acute care community hospital located in Wyoming, MN. M Health Fairview Lakes Medical Center provides comprehensive medical services in cardiology, gastroenterology, oncology, family practice, surgical care, and obstetrics and gynecology. The Emergency Department is designated as a Level IV trauma center and Urgent Care is open seven days a week. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has given the hospital a 5-star rating based on 57 quality measures. The hospital is part of M Health Fairview Health System, a nonprofit network of hospitals, clinics and other health care services in Minnesota.
