
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M HEALTH FAIRVIEW SOUTHDALE and RIDGES PGY2 Health System Pharmacy Administration and Leadership Residency





Program Overview

The Health System Pharmacy Administration Residency is a 12-month program focused on community hospital pharmacy management. The resident will spend time at both M Health Fairview Southdale Hospital and M Health Fairview Ridges hospital.

M Health Fairview Southdale Hospital is a 329 bed medical center that provides comprehensive medical services in more than 40 specialty services. M Health Fairview Ridges Hospital is a 150 bed medical center providing state-of-the-art care to residents of the Minnesota River Valley since 1984.

Each resident's experience is tailored to individual interests and skill development needs. The program focuses on the development of leadership and management skills across two hospitals within M Health Fairview.

PGY2 Program Purpose: PGY2 residency programs build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and PGY1 pharmacy residency training to develop pharmacist practitioners with knowledge, skills, and abilities as defined in the educational competency areas, goals, and objectives for advanced practice areas. Residents who successfully complete PGY2 residency programs are prepared for advanced patient care or other specialized positions, and board certification in the advanced practice area, if available.
