Medication Therapy Management (MTM) services are offered by a pharmacist in our ambulatory clinics. We have utilized an automated medical record and computerized physician order entry system for our clinic patients since 2001. The hospital is part of M Health Fairview Health System, a nonprofit network of hospitals, clinics and other health care services in Minnesota.

Staffing

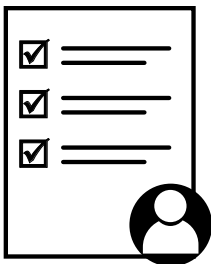
- Residents are scheduled to staff every fourth weekend along with some weekday shifts.
