Program Overview

The Pharmacy Residency Program (PGY1) at M Health Fairview Ridges Hospital in Burnsville, MN is a 12-month program consisting of core and elective learning experiences that are tailored to the resident's interests.

M Health Fairview Ridges Hospital is a 150-bed medical center providing comprehensive, specialized care to the southern Twin Cities community since 1984.

The Pharmacy Residency Program consists of direct patient care experiences in internal medicine, surgery, critical care, emergency medicine, transitions of care and other various specialty areas. Each resident's experience is tailored to individual interests and clinical skill development needs. The program also focuses on the development of leadership and management skills. A publishable residency research project will be designed and completed by the resident.

- One Internal Medicine learning experience
- One Critical Care learning experience
- One Clinical Management learning experience
- One Operations Management learning experience

Staffing

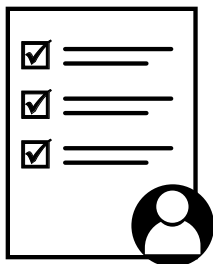
- Residents are scheduled to work every other weekend (eight hour shifts) and approximately three holidays
