



Woodwinds Health Campus – PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency

OPTIMAL HEALTH *and* WELL-BEING

Program Overview

The PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency Program at Woodwinds Health Campus in Woodbury, MN is looking to recruit one resident for the 2020-2021 residency year. Woodwinds Health Campus is part of HealthEast and will be tailored to meet resident’s interests in community hospital and ambulatory pharmacy practice.

Woodwinds Hospital, part of Woodwinds Health Campus, is an 86-bed facility focused on providing holistic care to patients. The primary patient populations include orthopedics, obstetrics, and general medicine. The resident will have the opportunity to complete rotations at other hospitals or clinics within the system (i.e. St. Joseph’s Hospital, medication therapy management clinics, etc.) to diversify clinical experiences. The resident will work closely with residents at other HealthEast and Fairview sites. The program provides a competitive salary, travel stipend, and benefits including 24 days of paid time off and medical, dental and life insurance.

Tentative Program Structure

This program structure allows for approximately 16 weeks (at least 4 rotations) of elective experiences
